Session #1

Tuesday, March 30, 2010 from 6:30 - 7:30 p.m.

Or

Wednesday, March 31, 2010 from 9:30 – 10:30 a.m.

Session #2

Tuesday, April 6, 2010 from 6:30 – 7:30 p.m.

Or

Wednesday, April 7, 2010 from 9:30 – 10:30 a.m.

You must attend either the March 30th or March 31st session in addition to one session from session #2 to be considered for application.

Upon completion of the orientation process, you will be given an application to complete. This application will be placed into the lottery, which will be held at the Classical Studies Academy on Wednesday, May 5, 2010 at 9:30 A.M.

It is a mandatory requirement for admittance into C.S.A. that every family contribute 40 hours of volunteer time to the school per school year. Failure to do so will result in your child being returned to your neighborhood school.

Please be advised that there is a sibling policy in effect for families with more than one child.
