Special week-long visit begins Saturday, April 26, 2008

WHAT: Visitors from Chile are arriving in the United States tomorrow for a special week-long visit to the Aquaculture School. This partnership is designed to give the Chilean visitors a better understanding of the teaching methodology used at the Aquaculture School, as a learning strategy.
