

SES TUTORING PROGRAM – 2011-2012

Bridgeport students **may be eligible** to receive supplemental educational services (SES). SES is a FREE tutoring program that is available to low income students attending schools that are identified as “in need of improvement” under NCLB guidelines, and **based on LOWEST tests scores**.

Schools qualifying for the FREE tutoring for the 2011-2012 school year include schools that have not made AYP (Annual Yearly Progress) for two or more years: Barnum, Batalla, Beardsley, Black Rock, Blackham, Bryant, Classical Studies Academy, Columbus, Cross, Curiale, Dunbar, Edison, Hallen, Hooker, Johnson, Longfellow, Madison, Marin, Read, Roosevelt, Tisdale, and Waltersville.

These services are offered by state approved providers and occur outside of the regular school day. Federal funding for the district is limited. Please see the names on the list of SES Providers servicing the Bridgeport district during the 2011-2012 school year.

Initial opportunities to obtain information about this free tutoring program and to meet the approved SES providers will take place at the district wide PAC meeting scheduled at Cesar Batalla School on Wednesday, September 21, 2011. The formal meeting will be held from 5:30 – 8:00 pm. SES providers will be allowed to meet and explain their services to the parents between 5:00 – 5:30 pm. District staff and home school coordinators will be available to assist with any questions or concerns.

Official registration forms, to receive tutoring services, will be available on September 26, 2011 at each qualifying school in the Bridgeport district. **A registration period will be held for two weeks from September 26, 2011 – October 7, 2011. No applications will be accepted after this date.** These forms can be obtained through the home school coordinator’s office or in the main office.
